(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said Elizabeth F. Ashmore,

All that piece, parcel, or tract of land, lying,  
being and situate in Grove Township, County and  
State aforesaid, about nine and one half miles  
South of the City of Greenville in the fork of  
the Fork Shoals road and the Log Shoals road,  
and more fully described as follows, to wit:  
Beginning at iron pin 34 on side of Fork Shoals  
road and running thence with Log Shoals  
road N. 54 1/4 E. 14.98 chains to iron pin 34 N. W.  
thence N. 14 1/2 E. 13.37 chains to pin in center  
of gully thence up the meanderings of said gully  
at a line 18.77 chains to iron pin 34 N. W.  
thence S. 9 3/4 E. 9.16 chains to stone 34, thence  
S. 59 1/2 W. 3.80 chains to pin in Fork Shoals road  
thence S. 18 1/2 E. 5.43 chains to bend, thence S. 24 E.  
6.39 chains to the beginning corner and containing  
twenty eight and one half (28 1/2) acres, said  
land, being the same tract of land conveyed
