Eleven hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by C. M. Todd

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. M. Todd, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land, lying and being in County and State aforesaid, on waters of Durban Creek, adjoining lands of S. J. Moore, J. P. Hippe, and others containing one hundred thirty and two tenths (116.2) acres more or less, as shown by a plat made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, of a Survey made by him on May 10th. 1918 being the same tract of land conveyed to me in three separate lots as follows: 1st. lot conveyed to me by W. F. Smith by deed dated Aug. 16th. 1883, A. D. and recorded in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. O. O. at page 495; 2nd. lot adjoining 1st lot on the East, conveyed to me by deed from W. C. Tomason dated Jan. 24th. 1888 A. D. and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. U. U. at page 168; 3rd. lot adjoining 1st lot on West and being same conveyed to me by deed from D. L. Jones dated Nov. 11th. 1905 A. D. and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. R. R. at page 26; Metes and bounds of tract herein conveyed (as per plat above, named C. M. Todd, and W. H. Boyeman corner, and running thence N. 20 1/4 E. 18.50 to a stake in center of Public Road, thence along said Road S. 69 1/2 E. 22.00 to a stone corner of J. P. Hippe, thence S. 17 W. 13.50 to a stone, thence S. 45 W. 5.34 to a poplar tree, thence S. 16 1/2 W. 6.75 to a stone (old pointer) thence down branch as a line to corner at junction of branches in Durban Creek, thence up second branch as a line in a westerly direction to a stone, thence N. 29 E. 3.40 to an oak tree, thence N. 35 1/2 W. 3.00 to a persimmon tree, thence N. 25 1/2 W. 2.30 to a stone, thence N. 10 E. 2.50 to a poplar on west bank of above said creek, thence up said creek 4.50 to a stake on west bank, thence N. 84 W. 5.70 to a stone on S. 
