(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *H. F. Seadin, his heirs and assigns forever*

All that parcel or tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing *Sixty-eight and 67/100* acres more or less and known as the *Long tract*, being a part of the real estate of *J. H. Smith*, deceased and designated on a plat made by *A. M. Dawson*, Esq. as tract No. 1 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone at N.
