unto the said Albert Nesbitt his heirs and assigns forever

All that lot of land situate in ward 9 of the
City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State
of South Carolina, on Nichols Street and having
the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning
at a point on the north side of said Street on
corner of lot now or formerly belonging to P. J.
Haynesworth, thence with said street S. 78 E. 50
feet to stakes, corner of lot no. 13 now owned by E. P.
Cartwell; thence with his line N. 13 E. 100 feet to
stake, thence north 78 W. 50 feet to corner of
Haynesworth lot, thence with the line of Haynesworth
lot S. 13 W. 100 ft to the beginning corner, and
being lot no. 12 of the lot property and being the
same lot of land conveyed to Rev. P. M. Cartwell,
