DEED TO A. C. Walker

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, L. A. James

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

DOLLARS,

in hand paid

to

A. C. Walker

at and before the sealing of these presents by A. C. Walker

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said A. C. Walker, his heirs and assigns:

1st: That piece, parcel or lot of land in the state and County of said, above described, now known of the City of Greenville being a part of the same, bounded and bounded the following manner and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone post situated on the corner of the said property, also known as corner, thence with the said line S. 43° 57' E. 350 feet to the ground point, thence N. 34° 10' E. 360 feet to another point, thence N. 43° 57' E. 350 feet to a corner point on Clarendon Avenue, thence with Clarendon Avenue N. 14° 10' E. 260 feet to the beginning corner, containing 2.08 acres, more or less, and in accordance with survey made by F. G. Rogers, D. S. October 1911. Subject to the following limitations, conditions and stipulations:

First: That said property shall be used for residential purposes, and for no other use only. This does not apply to servants.

Second: That no enclosure shall be erected on this property, except division thereon to cost less than \$3500.00, and thereof shall be built, erected and removed within twelve months from the date hereof.

Third: That the purchaser hereof, his heirs, administrators, executors, successors or assigns, shall be amenable to the sanitary rules and regulations passed by a majority of the Board of Health, purchased from the original Company. These conditions, limitations and restrictions are material and have material affect on the purchase price hereof, and are, therefore, conditions subsequent.

The above described lot of land is the same conveyed to me December 19th, 1911, by Colonial Company, dead recorded in Vol. 16, page 239, in the N.W.C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

As at part of the consideration hereof, the grantee herein agrees to pay, according to their terms, a note for \$4,000.00, with interest from the 16th day of July, 1917, secured by a mortgage on the within land, given by the grantee herein to Carrie L. Jackson, the 16th day of July 1912, in which mortgage is recorded in Vol. 2 of Book 223, which encumbrance is excepted from the warranties herein.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

A. C. Walker, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, L. A. James, do hereby bind

myself, my

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

A. C. Walker, his

heirs and assigns, against
