unto the said *H. E. Bradshaw*all that certain lot of land in South Carolina,
Greenville County, known as lot No. 4 of Brush Hill
Park according to the plat recorded in Plat Book
No. 96 An R. M. C. office for said Greenville
County, and said lot has the following mates
and bounds: Beginning at the intersection
of an alley, and Catawba Road, and running
thence S. 87° 10' W. 220 feet and five inches to
corner of lot No. 41, thence S. 62° 32' E. 157 feet and
three inches toward alley, thence with said
alley N. 27° 58' E. 155 feet and three inches, thence
continuing with said alley N. 20° 15' E. 26 feet
to the beginning corner, and being a part of
the same land conveyed to the Cherokee Land
Company by L. Q. Patterson and others, deeded re-
corded in said office in Vol. 21, at page 574,
and being the same lot conveyed to me by
the Cherokee Land Company by Deed dated 11th
