(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
 unto the said Annie Mai Fuller All of my right, title

and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest in and to the following described tracts of land.

All that certain tract situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the head waters of Endree River and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 3 1/4 Chains corner thence S. 33 N. 13. 96 ch to a stone, thence N. 72 N. 17. 58 ch to a stone 3 1/4 on Suffer line; thence N. 18 3/4 E. 6. 89 ch to a stone; thence S. 89 E. 22 ch to the beginning corner and containing seventeen (17) acres, more or less.

Also all that other tract situate in said County and State on the west side of the Greenville Road and run as follows: Beginning at stake at Greenville Road, thence N. 72 N. 17. 49 ch to a stone 3 1/4, thence N. 33 E. 13. 90 ch to a stone 3 1/4 on Greenville Road; thence with said Road S. 24 N. 13. 36 ch to the beginning corner and containing ten (10) acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to my father H.
