KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I J. P. Balleenger of the
County of Greenville,

In the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to me In hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Charles F. Hard

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Chas F. Hard, his heirs and assigns, all that certain pieces parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid and being known as Lot No. 30 of Oakland Heights, as shown by plat of said property recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at page 147, and having the following corners and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of lot No. 29 and 30, and running thence along line of lot No. 29 N. 34° 50' one hundred fifty (150) feet to an iron pin corner of lots 23, 24 and 29, thence S. 62° 19' E. Sixty (60) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34° 50' W. one hundred fifty (150) feet to an iron pin on Choice Street; thence along said Choice Street N. 62° 19' W. sixty (60) feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by J. A. Stover by his deed dated 19th day of February, 1917, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 46 at page 134. See also Vol. 41 at page 55, and Vol. 41 at page 84.

As a part of the considerations of this deed of conveyance, it is hereby understood and agreed that the said Chas F. Hard, is to assume and pay a mortgage of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars given by J. P. Balleenger to Kindness Bill Hamilton, as Guardian, and Mrs. Goldsmith, as General Agent, said mortgage dated March 9th, 1917, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 46 at page 136.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

Chas F. Hard, his
