

DEED TO O. M. Thompson

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. H. Rush of the City and County of Greenville

In the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

O. M. Thompson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said O. M. Thompson his heirs and assigns:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid, being the same lot of land conveyed by George ^{Westmoreland} to Mt. Zion Baptist Church by deed dated October 5, 1891 and recorded in Book 77 page 873 in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County and found by survey made by W. D. Neves, S. S. on January 8, 1913 to have the following meters and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake 37 on Hudson Street, thence with said street S. 22. 30 W. 77 feet to stake 37 of Hudson + meadow streets; thence with meadow street N. 56 W. 117 feet to P. C. Poag's lot, formerly Alice Johnson; thence with Poag's line N. 32. 45 E. 75 feet to iron pin, on thence S. 55 E. 109 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, master by deed dated January 10, 1913 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume 14 Page 101.

Thompson, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
