(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. M. Waters

all those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, South of Paris Mountain and more particularly described as follows: One lot containing two (2) acres, more or less and having such marks and bounds as follows: Beginning on a stone on Black Oak Stump, thence N. 57° E. 6.00 to a stone, thence S. 23 1/2 W. 3.34 to a stone, thence S. 57° E. 6.00 to a stone, thence N. 23 1/2 E. 3.35 to the beginning corner. Bounded by lands of L. M. Hubbard, Jerry E. Smith, A. A. Pike and M. P. Hale, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me, by Jerry E. Smith, by deed dated Jan. 6, 1909, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book E, p. 171 also that certain lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, containing three-fourths (3/4) of an acre more or less act per Survey of T. H. Rogers dated Dec. 10, 1910, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: Commencing at a stone on corner of Albert Pike and Jerry Smith on Mcbee line, running thence with A. and D.
