(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said J. E. Knight, Jr.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate,  
lying and being in Dunklin Township, County  
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having  
the following corner and bounds: Beginning  
at a Spring on a stone, thence S. 72 W. 23.63 to  
a stone, thence S. 79 E. 27.75 to a stone at the  
branch, thence along the branch N. 25.72 W. 7.80  
to a stake, thence N. 32 W. 2.85 to a stake,  
thence N. 38 W. 10.25 to a stake, thence N. 58 W.  
2.55 to a stake, thence N. 53 1/4 W. 9.40 to a stake,  
thence N. 59 1/2 W. 4.00 to a stake, thence N. 65 W.  
2.50 to the beginning corner containing 39  
and thirteen one hundredth acres, more or
