a certain tract or parcel of land known as the Abneris Waldrop home place, deeded to him by Rev. A. B. Bowens, on a branch of Jameson's Creek, beginning on a red Oak stump 7L 42 E. 24.50 chains South 6 W. 17.50 chains to a white Oak 3L, thence 7L 42 3/4 W. 24.50 chains to a pine on mt. church road; near the corner of the Burnett Cotton patch, thence north with the road East 9 chains to a black oak in York of the road near Abneris house, thence conditionally to the Rock corner 3L in the place of the Chestnut 4 9 E. 9 1/2 chains to beginning corner, containing nineteen acres the said same more or less, adjoining land of N.
