(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said T. W. King, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County, and State aforesaid, in Beutler Township near Roper Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Warren Green, J. D. Green and others, having the following metes and bounds: - Beginning at stake and apple tree and thence N. 36 3/4 W. 13.15 to iron pin in road leading to Greenville, S. C.; thence following the said road (a part of the way) S. 51 1/2 W. 21.35 to iron pin in settlement road; thence with said road S. 43 1/2 E. 15.25 to stake in gully; thence N. 47 1/2 E. 5.35 to stake; thence N. 50 E. 2.17 to stake; thence N. 6 1/4 W. 1.60 to stone 3 1/2 W.; thence N. 45 1/4 E. 4.65 to Locust; thence N. 61 1/2 E. 7.25 to the beginning, containing twenty-seven (27) and 25/100 acres, more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of J. D. Green, by deed dated October 24th, 1914, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book Vol. 26, Page 367. Also all that certain piece parcel and lot of land, situated in the State and County aforesaid, on the Congregational near Roper Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Mrs. Phillips, J. B. Rasor and others, being a part of a tract of land purchased by W. W. Lusk and J. W.
