the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said S. B. Hentry the following described

real estate, to-wit:  
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the  
incorporate limits of the City of Greenville,  
having a frontage on Wayward Street of 60 feet  
and a depth of one hundred fifty feet and bound-  
ed by lots now or formerly owned by J. R. Foster,  
E. B. Hamilton and others, being same lot con-  
veyed to J. R. Foster by Jos. A. Mc. Bullough April  
15<sup>th</sup> 1903, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for  
Greenville County in Book W W W at page 557."
