to me paid by the said Charles McAlister

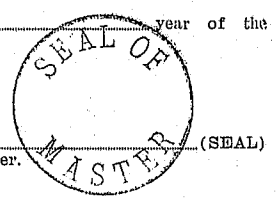
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said Charles McAlister, the following described real-estate, to-wit: All that certain

State aforesaid: Beginning at an iron pin 3X of Hulson & Jordan's line S. 68.40 E. 100 feet

102.7 feet to a stake by post 3X of Fred Symmes lot; thence N. 70 E. 161.9 feet to stake on
