KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Fannie S. Barr (formerly Fannie P. Stone) of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty Dollars, to me paid by Amy G. League
in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Amy G. League
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the City of Greenville on the south side of West Stone Avenue, commencing at a stake at the north east corner of lot no 12 of section "B" of plat of Stone Land Company's property and running thence S 0° 5' W 245 feet to a stake; thence S 85° 55' E 48 feet to an iron pin; thence N 5° 38' E 240 feet to an iron pin on the south side of said Stone Avenue; thence with stone Avenue N 83° 13' 72" feet to the beginning and being lot No 13 of section C of above mentioned plat; said plat recorded in Plat Book "A" pp 337, 345 and being one of the lots deeded me by Stone Land Company.

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W. E. Howard
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
