 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. A. Burns, of the County of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other considerations,
 to me paid by Louise Mc Gee Williams,
 in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Louise Mc Gee Williams
 all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the first ward, City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
 Beginning at a stake, 34, on the south side of Hampton Avenue, the East corner of lot sold by A. J. Gower to W. H. Davidson and Jesse W. Duncan, by deed dated August 9th, 1907, and recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County, in Book VVK, page 425; and runs thence with line of said lot South 57-10 West one hundred-sixty-seven (167) feet to a stake, 34; thence with line of same lot South 28 West twenty-three (23) feet to stake on right of way of Southern Railway; thence with line of right of way South 2-30 East twenty (20) feet to a stake, 34; thence, leaving same, East sixty one (61) feet to a stake; thence North 63-50 East one hundred-fifty (150) feet to a stake on south side of Hampton Avenue; thence, with line of said Street, North 35-15 West fifty-five (55) feet to the beginning corner.
