All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate lying and being in Greenville Township, Near the City of Greenville County, And State aforesaid, And having the following metes and bounds according to plat, of R. E. Dalton, Engineer, to wit, Beginning at an iron pin on Cedar Lane Road, on the South West corner of said road, and a 30 foot street, And running thence with said Cedar Lane road, N. 49° 10' W. 50.8 feet to an iron pin on the right of Way of the O & R. Ry. siding, thence with said right of Way S. 46° 48' W. 114 feet, to another iron pin, thence still with said right of Way S. 43° 47' W. 261 feet, to an iron pipe in line of land retained by Martin Cotton Oil Co. thence S. 71° 55' E. 213 feet, to an iron pipe on the corner of 30 foot Street, thence with the Western side of said 30 foot Street N. 18° 30' E. 316 feet, to point of beginning.
