One Hundred dollars and other valuable considerations,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Lucy L. Windman

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Lucy L. Windman, his heirs and assigns, all of that tract of land situate in Butler Township, in said County and State and described as follows: Beginning at a stone 3x at corner of lands of Temp. Muller and Sullivan, and runs thence S. 69.41 N. 232.7 feet to stone thence N. 20.02 E. 134.4 feet to arched pier corner of Conyers and Miller, thence S. 69.50 N. 121.8 feet to arched pier, thence S. 46.40 N. 179.1 feet to a stone; thence S. 61.45 N. 73.7 feet to a stone across the branch; thence S. 34.10 E. crossing the branch 22.40 feet to a stake; thence S. 53.43 N. 112.9 feet to a corner double highway; thence N. 37.05 E. 27.00 feet to a pile of rock corner; thence N. 33.10 E. 77.47 feet to the beginning corner, containing according to the survey and the print of W. D. News, June 21, 1917 four hundred and twenty (224) four acres more or less and being the same land conveyed to me by J. D. Jennings, the 20th day of April 1917 and recorded in Vol. 46 page 208.
