

J. F. Welborn DEED TO M. B. Leach

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. F. Welborn of the City of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifty Four hundred and Eighty (\$54,800.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. B. Leach

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

M. B. Leach, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid just without the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Augusta Road, known and designated as lot No. 10 as shown on plat of property of Parish & Sower, by R. E. Satter, Engineer, dated May 1919, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe on Augusta Road 79.53 feet from the intersection of Augusta Street and Prentiss Avenue, and joint corner of lots nos. 9 and 10, and running thence along line of lot No. 9 N. 42-07 E. 173 feet to an iron pipe; thence still with line of lot No. 9 N. 48-55 E. 65.8 feet to an iron pipe on a 45 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 56-28 E. 57.8 feet to an iron pipe joint corner of 15 foot alley, and alley running north from Augusta Street; thence S. 38-24 N. 75 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 42-09 N. 173 feet to an iron pipe on Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road N. 47-53 N. 60.3 feet to the point of beginning.

This being a lot conveyed to me by Parish & Sower by deed dated June 14th, 1919. Recorded in Vol. 54 page 49. Subject however to the following restrictions, which are part of the consideration for this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date this lot was conveyed to me as shown above, to wit:

- (1) The property herein conveyed no part thereof shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes.
- (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business, nor for anything which would constitute a nuisance.
- (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be recut nor subdivided, so as to face any other direction than is shown on said plat.
- (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within thirty feet of the present line of Augusta Street.
- (5) No building costing less than Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars shall be erected upon said lot, other than out buildings appurtenant to a dwelling.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

M. B. Leach, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND myself do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

myself heirs and assigns, against my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
