J. B. Freeman DEED TO George P. Cox

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. B. Freeman

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten (\$10.00) Dollars & other Valuables Consideration DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by George P. Cox

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said George P. Cox, All that tract or lot of land, situate lying and being in said State and County known as lot No. 9 of the said J. B. Freeman estate, and adjoining lots No. 1, No. 3, and No. 4 of the said estate, and lands of T. A. James having the following metes and bounds, viz: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of the Spartanburg Road, not far from the old residence of the said J. B. Freeman, running thence N. 22° 37' W. 298.5 chains to an iron pin in the road leading to Taylors; thence N. 24° 10' E. 10.20 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 84° 34' E. 3.70 chains to a stone; thence S. 35° E. 38.58 chains to a sweet gum on the branch; thence S. 26° 34' E. 3.84 chains to a stone; thence N. 61° 44' N. 7.40 chains to an iron pin on the North side of the said Spartanburg Road, thence along the said road S. 72° 34' W. 13.41 chains to the beginning corner, containing forty-nine and 78/100 acres more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. B. Freeman by J. F. Freeman and D. R. Freeman executors of the estate of J. B. Freeman deceased, by deed dated the 29th day of November, 1909, and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for said County and State in Vol. 5 page 402.

C. for Greenville County, in Book 71 at page 31, the value of the said mortgage being calculated as of this date \$18,600, and as settlement is made based upon these figures it is also understood and agreed that the grantee is hereby assigned all the right title and interest which the grantor may have his stock with the Federal Land Bank by reason of the loan as aforesaid.
