(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said M. A. Smith and his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Ward one of the City of Greenville, being known as lot number seventeen on plot of Towns Street property of W. C. Cleveland as made by W. D. Neely and approved by Harry J. Poe, Jr. City Engineer, Oct. 2nd 1909 and recorded in private plat book of Cleveland & Williams in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, and being further described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Neal Street common to lots Nos 16 and 17 and running thence N. 14° E. for 176.9 feet to a stake; thence S. 86° W. 61 ft to a stake; thence S. 14° W. for 176.1 ft. to a stake on said Neal Street. Thence with said Neal Street S. 76° E. for 60 ft to the Beginning Corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Ida R. Shearman 24<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1912 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County 30<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1912 in Vol. 14 page 1.

It is further understood and agreed and made a part of the consideration of the purchase price that the said M. A. Smith is to assume a mortgage of \$2,310.00 dated May 22, 1911 and interest on same from Oct. 29<sup>th</sup> 1912. This mortgage being given by Ida R. Shearman to W. C. Cleveland and recorded in R.
