KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Howard Caldwell, of Greenville
County,

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand and one hundred and thirtyone (\$4,131.00) Dollars, DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Pierce Pilgrim

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said Pierce Pilgrim, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, about fifteen miles south of the City of Greenville, on the Greenville Woodruff Road, land being known, and designated upon a plat of the J. M. Tilgore lands as Tract no. 5, and being a portion of the lands conveyed to me by J. M. Tilgore and Mr. M. Tilgore, by their deed dated the 1st of 1919, and being more specifically described as follows: Beginning on the Simpsonville road where it crosses Gilders Creek; thence along said road N. 7-40 E. 75 feet to bend; thence N 58 E. 333 feet to bend; thence N 63-10 E. 500 feet to bend; thence N. 62 E. 1100 feet to intersection of Simpsonville and Woodruff Road; thence along Woodruff Road S 39-09 E. 225 feet to bend; thence N. 81-10 E. 208 feet to bend; thence S 81-09 E. 193 feet to corner of lot no. 6; thence S. 1 E. 851 feet to maple on Gilders Creek; thence along said creek as a line to the beginning corner, containing 30.60 acres, more or less. It is understood and agreed that Pierce Pilgrim is taking the above lands as trustee for himself and Tiram Pilgrim and Joe Pilgrim and that toward the cash paid on the purchase price, Pierce Pilgrim contributes \$100.00, Tiram Pilgrim \$250.00, and Joe Pilgrim \$350.00.
