KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Addie E. Howard, and her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the state of south Carolina and county and city of Greenville in the sixth ward of said city, on the north side of Harris Street, and having the following lines, meters and bounds, according to a plat made by Will D. Neves, Eng'r October 22nd, 1913 of the Mrs. F. E. Harris Estate, to wit: Beginning at an Iron pin on the north side of Harris Street, 100 feet from the corner of ~~the~~ nona and Harris streets, and running thence in southwesterly direction along said Harris Street 50 feet to an Iron pin, joint corner of lots #33 and 34; Thence along line of lot #34 in a northwesterly direction 127 feet and 8 inches to an Iron pin in Whitmire's line; Thence along said Whitmire's line in a northeasterly direction 50 feet to a stake; Thence a straight line in a southeasterly direction 127 feet to the beginning corner, and being the major portion of lot #33 as shown on the above named plat, which plat is recorded in plat book C, at page 261; This being the greater portion of the lot of land conveyed to me by Sallie Hart Harris by deed dated 19th day of May, 1909 and recorded in the P. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol. # 44 of Deeds, at page 570 to which reference is made.
