(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. A. Todd and L. W. Todd, their heirs and assigns:-
 All that lot or parcel of land situate lying and
 being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid
 about 3 miles ^{north} of Simpsonville, known as a part of
 tract # 3 in a division of the real estate of Thos.
 Austin as appears by a plat made by J. M. Southern
 the 23rd of Oct. 1896 and having the following
 metes and bounds to wit:
