KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Caroline S. Marshall, Ida S. Netherland and Mary Steen.

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Maude N. Earle

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Maude N. Earle, all that certain lot of land situated in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as Mainly Street, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Mainly Street at the rear of lot of Miss Caroline S. Marshall, thence with her back line N. 76 E. 100 feet to an iron pin corner of drive way connected with the Loudson lot; thence S. 15 1/4 E. 50 feet to iron pin at the corner of said drive way and a 15-foot alley thence with said alley S. 76 W. 100 feet to iron pin on Mainly St. thence with Mainly Street, N. 15 1/4 W. 50 ft. to the beginning corner; being a part of the lot conveyed by Elizabeth F. Boyce et al to Caroline S. Marshall and Susan M. Marshall by deed dated Nov. 27, 1899 recorded in R. M. C. office in Book 494 at page 830.

This deed is a conveyance of the original interest of Caroline S. Marshall one-half, the interest which she acquired as heir at law of Susan M. Marshall deceased, one-sixth, the interest of Ida S. Netherland as an heir-at-law of Susan M. Marshall deceased, one-sixth and the interest of Mary Steen as an heir-at-law of Susan M. Marshall, deceased one-sixth.
