J. F. Weathers, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of  
land, lying and being in Fairview Township, County  
& State aforesaid, beginning at a stone corner at  
line of Mrs M. Elizabeth McDowell tract near the  
cemetery lot, thence 8.88 W. to south east corner of  
cemetery lot, thence parallel with Fairview Church  
and Academy lot 8.88 W. 4.50 chains to stone corner  
thence N. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 8.23 chains to stone, thence 8.0 links  
S. W. to stone corner, thence 8.88 W. 3 chains to stone  
corner, thence 8.8 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 12.00 chains to stone corner,  
thence 8.34 E. 16.50 chains to stone corner, thence N.  
56 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. parallel with Mrs M. R. L. Reden's land to
