KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. R. Ashmore, Jr. of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. Weathers

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. F. Weathers, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being in Fairview Township, County of + State aforesaid, beginning at a stone corner at line of Mrs W. Elizabeth McDowell tract near the cemetery lot, thence S. 88 W. to South east corner of cemetery lot, thence parallel with Fairview Church and Academy lot S. 88 W. 4.50 chains to stone corner, thence N. 75 1/2 S. 23 chains to stone, thence 80 links S. W. to stone corner, thence S. 80 W. 3 chains to stone corner, thence S. 8 1/2 W. 12.00 chains to stone corner, thence S. 34 E. 16.50 chains to stone corner, thence N. 56 1/2 E. parallel with Mrs M. R. L. Peden's land to line of Mrs W. Elizabeth McDowell's stone corner, thence parallel with line of Mrs W. Elizabeth McDowell N. W. to beginning rock corner near cemetery lot bounded by lands of Fairview Church on north, the old Sabbage place and A. S. Peden's land on West, Mrs M. R. L. Peden on South and Mrs W.
