KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. P. Bull,

in the State aforesaid,

One thousand (\$1000) Dollars and other Valuable Considerations

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by P. W. Jones and J. R. Hudson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

P. W. Jones and J. R. Hudson, their heirs and assigns,
 All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
 in the City of Greenville, on the west side of
 Laurens Street, between McBee Avenue and
 Washington Street and having the following
 meter and bounds: Beginning at an iron
 pin on the west side of Laurens Street, one hundred
 feet from the corner of McBee Avenue, and said
 Laurens Street, being corner of lot once owned by
 Alice M. Gates; thence with said Laurens Street
 N. 16 E. twenty-five feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74 W.
 one hundred feet to lot formerly owned by
 McDavid; thence with line of said lot S. 16 SW
 twenty-five feet to line of lot once owned by
 Alice M. Gates; thence with line of said Gates
 lot, S. 74 E. one hundred feet to the beginning.
 Being the same lot of land purchased by
 R. S. Huntington from Luther M. McBee, Jr. the
