DEED TO R. Mays Cleveland

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

J. H. Morgan of
Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten Dollars & other good & valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by R. Mays Cleveland

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

R. Mays Cleveland. All that certain piece parcel
and tract of land lying situate and being in
Bates Township State and County aforesaid, known
as the land conveyed to me by deed from H. G. Batson
September 12, 1911, and having the following metes and
bounds to-wit: Beginning in an ash tree 130 ft. on the
East fork of Bevardam Creek, running thence N. 97°
24' W. 101.0 chs. to a stone x m. (good pointers) thence S. 28 $\frac{3}{4}$
W. 16.85 chs. to a stake on West fork of Bevardam Branch
thence down the meanders of said branch 9.78 chs.
to a Maple tree m. thence S. 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 16.90 chs. to a stake,
gone on East fork of Bevardam Creek thence up the
meanders of said creek 41.74 chs. to the beginning
adjoining lands of Henry Batson Arthur Latherlin
and others and containing sixty four (64) acres more
or less. Surveyed by H. A. Hester Dec. 26, 1919.

Being the same tract of land conveyed by D.
P. Verner to H. G. Batson by deed recorded in Book
XII page 93, and by the said H. G. Batson to me
by deed dated September 12, 1911, recorded in Book

and State.
