to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by *R. E. Griffin*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

*R. E. Griffin and his heirs and assigns.*  
All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land  
lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid  
and on the Laurens Road about six miles south  
of the City of Greenville and containing one hundred  
acres, more or less and represented by a survey and  
plat of the same made for D. F. and F. L. Smith by  
R. E. Dalton Surveyor, and having the following courses  
and Distances:-

Beginning at an iron fence in Laurens Road and  
running thence along said road S 37-30 E. 200 feet  
to bend, thence S 19 E. 460 feet to bend; thence S. 18-06 E.  
2100 feet to bend; thence S. 14-20 E 114.9 feet to bend; thence  
leaving said road and running thence N. 14-58 E. 1165.5  
feet to stoke; thence S 14-40 E. 1909 feet to large stone; thence N.  
3-24 W. 300 feet to spike in Ry tire; thence along centre of  
C & H. R. R. N 3-24 W. 300 feet to bend in centre of Ry; thence  
along said Ry N 13-38 W. 400 feet to bend; thence N. 25-28  
W. 400 feet to bend; thence N 37-42 W. 400 feet to bend; then a  
N 37-42 W. 43 feet; thence leaving said Ry and running  
thence across spring branch near spring S 30 W. 2541.4  
feet to the beginning corner in Road.
