KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. N. Norwood

in consideration of the sum of
Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,
 to mein hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by T. L. Stone, L. A. Stone, and E. E. Stone

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

T. L. Stone, L. A. Stone and E. E. Stone, their heirs and assigns forever. - All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in Ward Five, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being on the corner of River and Hammond Streets, and being a portion of Lot 1, as shown upon a plat of the Mountain City Land and Improvement Company recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 33 at page 482, and being a portion of the lands conveyed to me by the Norwood National Bank, by deed dated November 7th, 1914, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 25, at page 41, and being more specifically described, as follows: Beginning at the corner of Hammond Street and River Street, and running thence along River Street S. 26-30 N. 38 feet; thence leaving River Street, running S. 63.30 E. to the line of Lot No. 15 on the plat above referred to; thence N. 49-15 E. along line of said lot to Hammond Street; thence along Hammond Street N. 27-40 N. 46 feet to a bend; thence continuing along Hammond Street N. 63.30 N. 154 feet to the beginning corner.

It is intended that this deed is to carry to the purchaser and their heirs and assigns an aerial way or light privilege covering a strip of five feet of land running the entire length of the building located on the above described lot on the south side thereof which aerial way cannot be closed except by the consent of all property owners concerned.
