KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, C. W. Grace

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
 Five Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by W. P. Gibson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W. P. Gibson, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid in the town of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a point on Congress Street and running thence with said Street 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence along the line of lot #6, 198 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, thence 57 feet to corner of lot #8; thence along the line of lot #8, 193 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning corner, and being known as lot #7 in Block 3 of the plat of land recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book A, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by S. E. Bruce by deed bearing date of December 11th 1913, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 26 page 168.

Also all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid and in the town of Greenville on the east side of Congress Street, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a point at the intersection of Congress and Green Streets; and running thence south with Congress Street 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of lot #7, nearly last course 193 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin; thence nearly north 57 feet to Green Street; thence along Green Street 186 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C. D. Johnson by deed bearing date of December 4th 1913, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 26 page 169.
