KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

P. O. Thomason

in the State aforesaid,

One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by E. J. Player and G. H. Schaefer

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

E. J. Player and G. H. Schaefer: All that piece parcel or lot of land, being and situated in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, in the first ward of the Greenville on the south side of Elford Street and being known as lot 3 as represented on plat of the estate of John H. O'Neil, which plat is recorded R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, Plat Book C, page 47 the lot being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Elford Street 186 feet West from the intersection of Elford and Main Streets and running thence along Elford Street N. 62-33 W. 38.2 feet to an iron pin, Hobbs Corner, thence along line of Hobbs property S. 27-11 W. 100 feet, more or less, to stake, thence S. 60-31 E. 41.2 feet to stake, corner of lot 2, thence with line of lot 2 N. 25-28 E. 100.8 feet to the beginning corner on Elford Street this being the lot conveyed to me by W. E. Phelps December 1st 1919, deed recorded R.M.C. Office, Greenville County deed book in Vol. 48, page 7. December 3rd 1919.
 However, the alley way herein conveyed and represented on said plat having a frontage of 9 feet on Elford Street and a width of 12 feet in the rear and running over the western part of lot is subject to an easement for the use and benefit of lot 4, on said plat for the purpose of ingress and egress.

As a part of the consideration of the purchase price of the within described property it is understood and agreed that the purchasers are to assume a note and mortgage of the sum of \$3000.00, which said note draws interest at 7 per cent semi-annually and is held by J. H. Pugh and recorded in book 69 page 156 R.M.C. Office, Greenville County S.C. And the purchasers are to keep the dwelling insured against fire, with a policy of \$2,500.00 in a strong and reputable company satisfactory to the holder of the above first mortgage.
