KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Hattie B. Stover

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
 One (\$10.00) Dollars & other valuable Considerations DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by M. H. Smith.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

M. H. Smith: lot No. 1, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Stone Avenue, and having the following Metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning at a stake on the said Stone Avenue at the corner of Johnstocks (formerly Furrman's) lot, thence S. 5° N. two hundred and thirty (230) feet to a stake; thence S. 88 1/2 E. Seventy-four (74) feet and three (3) inches to a stake; thence N. 5° E. two hundred and twenty-eight (228) feet and six (6) inches to a stake thence N. 84 1/2 W. seventy-four (74) feet and three (3) inches to the beginning being the same lot conveyed to me by George V. Bell by deed dated the 12th October 1916, which is duly recorded in the Register of Mesne Conveyance Office for State and County aforesaid in Book 4, Page 216. also - lot no 2

All that strip or parcel of land adjoining lot no. 1, on the rear and being twelve (12) feet more or less wide and one hundred thirty-one (131) feet more or less long, and being the rest and residue from belonging to one of that lot of land conveyed to me by Eva B. Irvin by deed dated February 1917, by deed duly recorded in aforesaid Register of mesne Conveyance Office in Vol. 46, Page 257.

For value received, I hereby release from the within described lot of land, the sum of a certain Mortgage executed and delivered to me by Hattie B. Stover on August 29, 1919, securing a note of even date therewith of Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars. Said Mortgage being recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 85, Page 116.
