(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

M. W. Howard, All that certain piece of parcel
 or lot of land situate in the County and State
 aforesaid, a short distance without the Corporate
 limits of the city of Greenville, and having the
 following Metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at
 an iron pin on the south side of a 20 foot street
 now known as Brockman street, being the North-
 West corner of the property conveyed to J. J. Simpson
 by S. N. Seawright by deed dated April 1st, 1916, and
 recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
 Deed Book 34, Page 217; and running thence S.
 37° W. 231 feet to iron pin; thence S. 51° E. 204 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
 to iron pin, thence N. 31-30 E. 158 feet to iron
 pin, thence N. 12-30 E. 53.8 feet to southeast corner of
 lot conveyed by J. J. Simpson to S. N. Seawright
 by deed dated June 26th, 1917, and recorded in R. M. C.
 Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 43, page
 168, thence with line of last mentioned lot in a
 westerly direction 90 feet to the southwest corner of
 said lot on the east side of Seawright Street;
 thence with the east side of Seawright Street in
 a northerly direction 95 feet to a point on Brock-
 man Street, the northwest corner of lot last men-
 tioned; thence with Brockman Street N. 77 $\frac{1}{4}$ N.
 85 feet to the beginning corner being all of the tract
 conveyed to J. J. Simpson by S. N. Seawright by deed
 first above mentioned except that portion cut
 from the northeast corner of said tract and
 re-conveyed by J. J. Simpson to S. N. Seawright, by
 deed recorded in Deed Book 43, Page 108. On the
 property herein conveyed there are situate fifteen
 dwellings this being the same property conveyed
 to me by J. J. Simpson by deed dated September 6,
 1918, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
 County in Deed Book Vol. 51 page 181.
