DEED TO Austin S. Parker & George B. Goldsmith

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, N. D. Parish & J. C. Gower

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
 Two Dollars & other valuable consideration
 to us DOLLARS,
 in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by Austin S. Parker and
 George B. Goldsmith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Austin S. Parker & George B. Goldsmith,
 all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State
 aforesaid, on the east side of Augusta Street, in the
 City of Greenville, iron and designated as lot no.
 2, as shown on plat of property of Parrish & Gower
 by A. C. Dalton, Engineer dated May 1919, recorded in
 the C. M. C. Office for Greenville County in vol. 8, Page
 136, and having the following Metes and bounds, to-wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of
 Augusta Street 37 ft. 3 feet from the intersection of
 Augusta Street and Trentis Avenue, joint corner
 lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence with line of lot
 no. 3 N. 42-07 E. 169 feet to an iron pin on a 15
 foot alley thence with said alley N. 53-03 W. 136 feet to
 an iron pin joint rear corner lots nos. 1 and 2,
 thence with line of lot no. 1, S. 42-07 W. 147.6 feet to an
 iron pin on Augusta Street; thence with Augusta St.
 S. 42-53 E. 137.50 feet to the point of beginning.

Being a portion of the property conveyed to us by
 Eagle Park Company by deed dated May 26th 1919,
 and recorded in the C. M. C. Office for Greenville County
 in vol. 25 Page 448.

Subject however to the following restrictions, which
 are part of the consideration for this deed, and are
 made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown
 on the plat, above referred to which restrictions shall
 remain effective for a period of twenty years from
 the date of this Deed.

- (1) The property herein Conveyed nor any part thereof shall
 not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to Negroes.
- (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful
 business nor anything which would constitute a nuisance.
- (3) The property herein Conveyed shall not be reut nor
 subdivided so as to face any other direction than is
 shown on said plat.
- (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within
 thirty-five feet of the present line of Augusta Street.
- (5) No building costing less than four thousand (\$4,000.00)
 Dollars shall be erected upon said lot, other than out
 buildings appurtenant to a dwelling.
