(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. C. Redman, All those certain lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville on the South side of West Coffee Street between Laurens and Richardson Streets and being more and designated as Lots 1, 2 and 3 on a plat of property of J. J. Westervelt made by R. C. Dallow December 1919 and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat: Beginning at a point in the South side of West Coffee Street which point is 87 feet 2 inches West of the southwest corner of Coffee and Laurens Streets, and running thence with West Coffee Street 53 feet 7 inches to a point on South side of West Coffee Street; thence with Goldsmith's line of S. 22-42 W. 88 feet 5 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 68-12 E. 53 feet 9 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 22-39 E. 9 feet 2 1/2 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 21-54 E. 79 feet 2 1/2 inches to the point of beginning.
