all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, in Belcher Springs Township, near the National Highway between Greenville and Spartanburg, about 7 miles from Greenville Court House, containing three acres, more or less, and being a part of a fifteen (15) acre tract of land bought by me from M. R. Garrett, December 7, 1886, by Deed recorded in the R. M. L. Office for said State and County, in Vol. 57, page 247, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a pin in the center of the South bound track of the Southern Railway, thence S. 11 E. 136 feet to the corner of the tract of land this day conveyed by me to R. F. Watson and W. T. Adams; thence in an easterly direction, parallel with said South bound track of Southern Railway along line of land this day conveyed to R. F. Watson and W. T. Adams, 136 feet to a point on R. F.
