Avenue; Beginning at a stake on a twenty foot alley thence
along said twenty foot alley, S. 71 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. one hundred and twenty
five (125) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. forty-eight
(48) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. one hundred and
twenty-five feet (125) to an iron pin on the Eastern bound-
