(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. Frank Smith, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, and State and County aforesaid, fronting on Butler Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds; courses and distances: Beginning at a stake on said Butler Avenue at corner of lot on which is the present residence of H. A. Wallace, and running thence along said Avenue N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  E, seventy (70) feet and three (3) inches to corner of lot of J. D. Gilbreath; thence S. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  E, eighty three (83) feet and seven (7) inches to stake on line of lot of Mrs. F. C. Buchanan; thence along her line in a South Westerly direction on street twenty-nine, (29) feet and six (6) inches to stake on line of lots of myself and Buchanan lot; thence in a South East direction along lots of Buchanan and Morgan, about seventy-eight (78) feet to stake on line of Morgan lot; thence along line of residence lot of H. A. Wallace, N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  W, one hundred and forty-five (145) feet, in a straight line to the beginning point on Butler Avenue.
