 On Both sides of Laurel Creek, waters of Reedy River,  
 containing thirteen and three quarters (13 3/4) acres,  
 more or less, and having the following metes and bounds  
 to wit: Beginning at a rock 3x n.m., oak branch and run-  
 ning thence N. 45° 2' W. 3.50 chains to a persimmon 3x n.m.;  
 thence N. 31 W. 1.63 chains to spring, corner in the  
 spring; thence due North 2.00 chains to three old  
 oaks 3x n.m. on the Road; thence N. 32 3/4 W. 2.90  
 chains to pine 3x n.m.; thence N. 45 1/2 W. 2.40 chains to
