J. D. Bridges, a strip of land containing one-third of an acre, more or less commencing in the center of a spring corner of W.A. Bowling property and other property of J. D. Bridges, thence along line of Bowling property 2.31 E. 26.3 feet to a stake, said stake being 7.74 E. 5 feet from a stone which was formerly a corner between property of W.A. Bowling and J. D. Bridges thence along line of said Bowling property S. 8.57 E. 23.8 feet to a stake on line of other property of J. D. Bridges; thence along said line N. 89.34 W. 81.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Griffin and others N. 2.29 E. 2.25 feet to a stake; thence crossing a branch N. 72.08 E. 29.5 feet to a stone referred to above; thence N. 3.58 W. 26.3 feet to the center of said spring at the point of beginning surveyed by R.
