to wit: Beginning at a stake on Byncomb Street and
running thence with Byncomb Street N. 33° 0' W. one
hundred eighty and four-tenths (180.4) feet to the point of the
intersection of Byncomb and College Streets; thence with
College Street S. 66° 0' 2" W. Two hundred fourteen (214) feet
