KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. Penoyer,

in consideration of the sum of seven thousand (\$7,000.00) — in the State aforesaid,

to me paid by Ronnie M. Spinkes

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Ronnie M. Spinkes

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville ... Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. In the sixth ward of the City of Greenville, on the south side of Tindal Avenue, corner of lot number 42 as shown on plat hereinafter referred to, and running thence with line of lot number 42, S. 30-36 E. 160.5 feet to iron pipe in line of lot number 7, thence with line of lot number 7 N. 73-01 E. 50 feet to iron pipe corner of lot number 40; then with line of lot number 40 N. 16-41 W. 155.5 feet to iron pipe on Tindal Avenue and thence with Tindal Avenue along a curved line approximately S. 77-27 W. 61 feet to the beginning corner known as lot number 41 of Block B. to plat of Eagle Park recorded in plat Book C, page 238, and being the same lot of land conveyed to the Eagle Park Company by J. C. Haley by deed dated January 1917, and recorded in Book H, page 165.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions which are part of the consideration of this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of this deed, to wit:

1= The property herein conveyed nor any part thereof shall not be sold, rented, nor otherwise disposed of to negroes.

2= The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor anything which would constitute a nuisance.

3= The property herein conveyed shall not be resubdivided or re-zoned except as otherwise directed than as shown on said plat.

4= No building shall be erected on said property within 20 feet of the present line of Tindal Avenue.

5= No building costing less than twenty-five hundred dollars shall be erected upon said lot other than buildings appertaining to a dwelling.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Mrs. Mandie Rose Davis on the 7th day of January, 1919, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 51, Page 263.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Ronnie M. Spinkes her

heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ronnie M. Spinkes, her

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
