in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said, G. T. Mc. Kissick, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and more particularly described as follows,

Beginning at an iron pipe on the East side of Clarendon Avenue corner of the G. C. Walker property, and runs thence S 43° 55' E. three hundred and (300) feet, thence N 46° 10' E. one hundred and twenty four (244) and a half feet to corner of the J. G. Arvey property, thence with the hickey that lot N 43° 10' W. three hundred and eight (308) feet to Clarendon Avenue, thence north said Avenue S 46° 10' W. one hundred and twenty (124 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet and a half feet to the beginning corner, containing One (1) acre more or less. Subject however, to all of the conditions and restrictions set forth in the deed by Columbia Company to J. M. Manning deed recorded in Vol. 117 at page 121.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee herein does hereby assume and will pay the remainder due on two notes, which are secured by mortgages on the above described land, all dated the 1st day of June 1921, were given by the grantor to W. It is agreed that the remainder, due as aforesaid, is as of July 1st, 1921, the sum of \$7845.00 and that the grantee herefore will pay all interest accruing thereon from that date according to the terms of said notes and mortgages.

Also that the grantee will pay all taxes and assessments on said land for the year 1921.


