In the city of Greenville on the south side of Ann Street, beginning at a stake on Ann Street at corner of lot of John M. Steele, thence with his line S. 13-45 E. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ for a stake; thence N. 76-15 E. 64 feet to a stake, thence N. 13-45 W. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet with line of lot no. 20 to a stake on Ann Street, thence with north side of Ann Street S. 80-15 W. 64 feet to the beginning corner, known as lot no. 10 on a plat of the lands of E.
