unto the said.

W.E. Reeves, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate to-wit:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid, and being known and designated as lot No. 6 of Block A., of the
estates of J.W. Cagle and W.L. Mauldin, according to a subdivision and plat thereof as
traced and restaked by W.D. Neves, Eng. on April 5, 1919. Said lot having a frontage
of 70 feet on Cagle Street and running back in parallel lines 150 feet to an alley.
