the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

F. L. Henry and Wm. F. Jackson and their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the corner of Hampton Avenue and Duncan Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point, the corner of Hampton Avenue and Duncan Street and running thence along Hampton Avenue S. 54° 14' E. 69.1 feet to a point on Hampton Avenue; thence N. 27° 07' E. 137 feet to an iron pin corner of Latimer estate; thence N. 59° 02' W. 77.4 feet to an iron pin on Duncan street; thence along Duncan street S. 25° 10' W. 129.5 feet to the beginning corner there being situate on said lot two two-story dwelling houses."
