the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said.

*Annie B. O'neal, her heirs and assigns forever, the following
described real estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate
lying and being in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, County
and State aforesaid, and on the north side of Poinsette
Avenue and being known and designated as lot no. 48, on
the plat of W. C. Cleveland property made by R. C. Dalton
on March 14 1910, which plat is duly recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "B" - page 11
Said lot has frontage of 70 feet on Poinsette Avenue and
runs back in parallel lines a depth of 219.9 feet and
247.5 feet respectively, with a width of 75 1/2 feet in the rear."*
